Attendance - Every day counts.

We need your continuing help to improve our attendance figures so please send your child every day, if they are well, as every day counts. If they have the odd sniffle or cough please send them to school. We will send them home if they are unwell. If your child does have sickness and/or diarrhoea then please keep them off for 48 hours after their last bout as this will help to prevent it spreading.

You will receive a print out of your child's current attendance at parents' evening. Above 97% is excellent, above 95% is good and below 95% we will monitor your child's attendance. Below 90% could result in an attendance meeting and involvement from our Educational Welfare Team.

Check P.E kits

Please make sure all school clothes are labelled particularly PE kits. If you could check T-shirts, shorts and trainers have your own child's name in them when they bring them home. This will really help the Teachers. Children sometimes pick the wrong bag up by mistake and then another child is missing a P.E kit for the next session.

Head Lice

There have been quite a few reported cases of Head Lice across School. Please can you check your child's hair tonight and treat if required.

We suggest the following procedure for inspecting your child for head lice:

- 1. Under bright light begin looking at the back of the head just above the neck area.
- 2. Part the hair section by section and look closely for head lice or nits (eggs). Eggs will usually be located near the scalp.
- 3. Depending on the length and thickness of the hair, it should take between 5 and 15 minutes to properly inspect a child's head.

If you suspect your child is infested with head lice please treat your child promptly. In addition, the entire family should be inspected for head lice as well.

Your child does not need to take time off school for treatment.
