#### <u>Attendance</u>

### Please support us and send your child every day.

If your child is ill please ring the office on 01909 721471 with the reason for their absence. Doors to school open at 8:40am and children will be registered from 8:50am. If you arrive after 8:50am please notify the office to safeguard your child and ensure they are registered as present. The gates will remain unlocked until 9:00am.

### Absence for sickness

If your child has a temperature and feels unwell then please keep them at home. If your child has sickness &/or Diarrhoea then please keep them off school for 48 hours after their last bout.

### Rainbow Attendance Challenge

Our Rainbow Challenge has started! Each class has a rainbow displayed. For every full week of attendance, your child will move up/across a colour towards the top/end of the rainbow. Once they reach the top, they will receive a prize. They can then start again. This means over the year the children get many chances to get an attendance prize.
