Application for School Places - Nursery to Reception Class (Sept. 2019 start)

If your child was born between 1 Sept. 2014 and 31st Aug. 2015 you need to apply for an Infant School place before midnight on Tuesday 15th Jan. 2019.

Application for School Places – Junior School (Sept. 2019 start)

If your child was born between 1 Sept. 2011 and 31st Aug. 2012 you need to apply for a Junior School place before midnight on Tuesday 15th Jan. 2019.

Applying after the deadline may mean missing out on a place at our school or the Juniors. Apply online at <u>www.derbyshire.gov.uk/admissions</u> Alternatively apply by phoning 01629 537499 this takes about 15 minutes.

You will be notified of your child's school place, by email, on 16th April.

<u>Reminder</u>

* Please do not use inappropriate language in front of other parents, staff or children on the school grounds. It is important we set a good example at all times.

<u>Head Lice</u>

There have been quite a few reported cases of Head Lice across School. Please can you check your child's hair tonight and treat if required.

We suggest the following procedure for inspecting your child for head lice:

1. Under bright light begin looking at the back of the head just above the neck area.

- 2. Part the hair section by section and look closely for head lice or nits (eggs). Eggs will usually be located near the scalp.
- 3. Depending on the length and thickness of the hair, it should take between 5 and 15 minutes to properly inspect a child's head.

If you suspect your child is infested with head lice please treat your child promptly. In addition, the entire family should be inspected for head lice as well.

Your child does not need to take time off school for treatment.
