Deadline for applications

Application for School Places – Nursery to Reception Class (Sept. 2023 start)

If your child was born between 1 Sept. 2018 and 31st Aug. 2019 you need to apply for an Infant School place before midnight on Sunday 15th Jan. 2023.

Application for School Places – Junior School (Sept. 2023 start)

If your child was born between 1 Sept. 2015 and 31st Aug. 2016 you need to apply for a Junior School place before midnight on Sunday 15th Jan. 2023.

Applying after the deadline may mean missing out on a place at our school or the Juniors. Apply online at <u>www.derbyshire.gov.uk/admissions</u>. You will be notified of your child's school place, by email, on 17th April 2023.

Suitable playtime clothing

It is very important that your child is dressed for the weather. Please make sure they have warm clothing for outside play and suitable footwear.
