If your child was born between 1 Sept. 2013 and 31<sup>st</sup> Aug. 2014 you need to apply for a Junior School place before midnight on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2021. Some part time staff are doing additional hours so we can minimize the number of adult contacts children have.

Children need the routine of arriving, registering and getting straight to learning so it is vital you arrive before the gate closes at 9am.
