Most families face challenging behaviour from their children at some point and knowing where to turn to for help and support can be difficult.

The goal of the Incredible Years Parenting Course is to prevent and treat young children's behaviour problems and promote social, emotional wellbeing.

What will sessions include?

Incredible years looks at issues such as play, positive praise and rewards, limit setting and handling unwanted behaviour.

Parents of children aged between 2 to 8 years old.
