### Assessment

- Foundation subject assessment: Assessing against learning objectives each term.
- Termly Foundation Subject Assessment sheet highlighting objectives covered and who is working towards expected level and who is working at greater depth (All others assumed working at expected level).

### Religious Education Lesson Structure

#### **Review prior knowledge**

- Recap on prior learning by using key question/image Quiz
- Vocabulary used
- Clip art image on teaching slides

#### **New Teaching**

- Introduce learning and success criteria for the lesson - what will we be able to do/know by the end of the lesson.
- Model discussion and learning
- Independent practice
- Adaptions to challenge more able children.
- Scaffold activities to support children with specific needs.

#### **Lesson Review**

- Share work with partner, small groups or whole class.
- Evaluate work - What have we been learning? How these skills could be transferred to other areas of our learning
