- The School Crossing Patrol Supervisor has contacted school. There have been a number of younger children running on the road before Helen, our crossing person, has been able to get to the middle and stop traffic. It is extremely worrying for Helen. Please make sure your child either stands with you or holds your hand at the kerb. Helen will let you know when it is safe to cross. This is particularly important as it is not a zebra crossing and not all vehicles stop, as they should. We have invited Helen and Clare (Northern Supervisor of School Crossing Patrols) to speak to our Nursery children this half term. They will talk to the children about Helen and her job. We hope with your support and with a visit from Helen we can ensure the continued safety of the children when walking to and from school.
