Recall simple stories connected with Easter and a festival from another faith. Say why these times are special.	<b>F5 Where do we belong?</b> Re-tell religious stories making connections. Share times in our lives when we have felt special. Recall what happens at a traditional Christian baptism.	<b>F6 What is special about our world?</b> Think about the wonders of the natural world. Express ideas about how to look after plants and animals. Talk about what people do to mess up the world and how we should look after it.
