Club dates

We will endeavour to provide the Breakfast service every school day from Tuesday 3rd November to Friday 11th December. Please note we are not running Breakfast Club in the last week of Autumn Term. The only exception will be if we have insufficient staffing due to COVID –19. We will provide as much notice as is possible if this happens.

Payments

This is to be paid in full at the start of each week. Payment should be given to Steph Burton, Breakfast Club Leader.

Breakfast Provision

A nutritious breakfast is served daily. Your child will be offered a choice of cereals, bagels or toast.

Juice or water will also be offered.

Magic Breakfast provides most of our food and drink. Our website provides further information on the food and drink ingredients and allergens.

Activities

Your child will have the opportunity to take part in the various activities that are provided, games, books, wheeled vehicles, construction and colouring. All activities will be suitable for their age group.

Staffing

The breakfast club is led by Mrs Burton. Mrs Beech and Mrs Robinson will be running the club each day. Staff will wear face masks to receive your child at their classroom at 8:40am but they will not be required to wear them thereafter.

There will always be a member of staff available with First Aid Training.

Admissions policy

Under the current COVID-19 situation places will be limited to year one and year two pupils.

You may book your child's space via email, BreakfastClub@creswell-inf.derbyshire.sch.uk

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. You can book for the term, but payment will need to be in full to secure the place. Refunds will only be given for COVID-19 symptoms and self-isolation. Refunds for other reasons will not be given as the money is used towards weekly staffing provision.

You may cancel your booked place up to 7:50am on the Monday for the whole week, you cannot cancel individual days.

Children's Records

An attendance register is kept. This will be also used if any positive COVID –19 tests are provided so we can inform parents if a child has been in close contact with them.

Records of accidents and behaviour issues will be kept in the same way as we do for school times.

Parents are responsible for updating personal details as required. We need to have contact numbers in case of illness or accidents. We also may need to contact you if the club is not able to run through staff illness.

COVID –19

Children should not attend Breakfast Club if they have any COVID-19 symptoms.
